Re: Termination of our Free Consultation Program

Dear Friends, Colleagues, Technicians, and Shop Owners,

It is with a heavy heart that I must suspend our free consultation program. Due to an unprecedented demand for our services and our time, I must begin charging for initial consultations.

In the past, we have always been generous with our time, understanding that talking to someone to answer simple questions, concerns, and getting an idea of costs and whether or not representation is right for you has been our primary concern. I entered the practice of law, and specifically representing individuals of the Automotive Repair and Emission Testing Industry, 7 years ago because I saw an under represented and oppressed community who did not have a fighting voice.

I saw a Governmental Agency, the Bureau of Automotive Repair, shoot "fish in a barrel" when there were few Attorneys who could cross examine a Bureau of Automotive Repair documentation lab expert who was misinforming an Administrative Law Judge.

So, we went to work.

Unfortunately, I can no longer keep up with demand. We currently carry a roster of close to 1,500 shops, facilities, and technicians who we represent or have represented in various legal matters. As the Bureau of Automotive Repair has increased regulatory control over the industry, there is constant demand for assistance with navigating this difficult area of the law.

We currently have approximately 300 active cases, including, but not limited to STAR Invalidations, Accusation cases for Transmission Shops, Auto Body Shops, Repair Facilities, Emission Testing Facilities, and Technicians, Citations, Petition for Interim Suspension Orders, Criminal cases for allegations of improper Smog Check Inspections, Repair issues, etc.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair has a roster of over 100 employees. The Department of Justice, Office of the Attorney General, who represent the Bureau of Automotive Repair in Administrative Hearings, has a Licensing Division in San Francisco, Oakland, Sacramento, Los Angeles, and San Diego with approximately a dozen licensing Attorneys who handle Bureau of Automotive Repair cases. There are also various Environmental Crimes and Consumer Fraud Units in District Attorney's Offices throughout the state who have started prosecuting facilities and technicians for allegations of criminal violations from repair and emission testing allegations.
